Participants enhance their skills through three hands-on sessions centered around a customized assessment of leadership behaviors and their strategic application; business analysis and problem-solving; and experiential learning through collaboration, networking, and peer group interaction, culminating in a group project presentation. About the Program

The Residential Future Leaders Program has three core learning objectives:

Learn from a 360-degree leadership assessment: Participants receive a well-rounded view of their current leadership behaviors through a self-assessment and feedback from peers, subordinates, and superiors. Participants will use this feedback, coupled with peer idea exchanges, to develop and execute a personalized action plan.

Develop strategic problem-solving and team-building skills: Participants apply leadership practices in a team project based on a real-life mortgage business scenario. Together, participants formulate strategies for maximizing organizational performance and improving employee engagement, while refining their writing and presentation skills through a comprehensive paper and delivering a presentation to a panel of industry experts.

Learn and apply leadership best practices: Participants explore effective solutions to common challenges through leadership case studies, models, and frameworks. Participants build leadership skills and gain insight into the importance of industry policy and advocacy through networking opportunities with senior industry leaders.
