

Certificate Exemption Form

EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS

You may apply for an exemption to waive the coursework for the Level I and Level II programs only and if you meet the requirements. Please submit a current resume and the Exemption form to Tony Clynès at tclynès@mba.org to request an exemption.

- Exemption fees are collected based on the enrollment fee of the course the exemption is granted.
- Exemptions are currently available only for the first two levels of the RCMS, CMCP, and CRU Designation programs.

LEVEL I

If you have at least three years of experience in the related field, you can apply for an exemption to waive the coursework and go directly to the test. It is recommended that you have a minimum of three years of mortgage industry experience.

Once you have applied for the exemption, you must pass the Level I assessment on the first attempt. If you do not pass the test on the first attempt, you may test again after enrolling in Level I and successfully completing all required Level I courses.

LEVEL II

If you have completed all the requirements for Level I and you have at least five years of experience in the related field, you can apply for the Level II exemption to waive the coursework and go directly to the test. Once you have applied for the exemption, you must pass the Level II assessment on the first attempt. If you do not pass the test on the first attempt, you may test again after enrolling in Level II and successfully completing all required Level II courses.

NOTE: If you applied for the Level I exemption, but did not pass on the first attempt, you are not eligible to exempt out of the Level II component.
